### **What To Bring To Your Appointment**

- Valid passport (mandatory)
- Valid HAP ID number
- Spectacles or contact lenses if you wear them
- Copies of GP and/or specialist reports, if available, for significant medical conditions

#### Note:

- eMedical applicants do not need to bring forms or photos
- ALL Australian visa medicals are now carried out on eMedical

## **What To Expect During The Examination**

- All applicants over the age of 15 years will have a full medical examination including a blood test to assess kidney function (eGFR and serum creatinine test).
- The medical itself involves a physical examination, where the applicant will undress to underwear whilst wearing a gown.
- If you would like a chaperone present during the medical examination, please do not hesitate to request one.
- Most applicants aged 11 years and above will need a chest X-ray.
- Permanent Visa applicants aged 15 years and above will require blood tests for HIV status.
- All doctors, dentists or nurses working in healthcare will require blood tests for HIV, Hepatitis B and C.
- No need to fast but please be well hydrated.
